

Registration for 2017/18

Plans are underway for next year and we need our enrollment estimates to be as accurate as possible.

- If you live in our catchment area and your child is already in our school, you do not re-register. We transition those students into next year's enrollment automatically. Our grade 6 students will transition automatically to Dr. Kearney Middle School. You do not need to register them with DKMS.
- If you do not live in our catchment area and are attending on a variance, you need to speak with the office regarding next year's placement.
- If you know of anyone new in our area with school-aged children, please encourage them to register with us as soon as possible. Children born in 2012 may be enrolled to attend kindergarten in the fall
